The **Abundant Amelia** project was undertaken by Southwark council in the summer of 2011 to provide areas of green space for the residents of Crampton, Peacock and Illiffe Street.

The ArborRaft system was chosen by the council for the construction of the tree planting areas. The ArborRaft structure accommodates the vertical and lateral forces from vehicular loading ensuring that the soil within the growing space remains uncompacted.

The ArborRaft provides as ideal subbase layer for the pavement and the air gap within the system prevents root growth from damaging the hard surfacings and facilitates re-oxygenation of the soils and the Movement of water through the system.
